The trustees of Shaker Museum | Mount Lebanon unanimously elected John Campbell and Kathy Weiser to the Board on Saturday, November 16.

Born in London, England, and recently relocated full-time to Austerlitz, NY, John Campbell spent 17 years in the financial industry, eventually serving as Chief of Staff for Citigroup's Global Digital Strategy. In recent years John founded JCINTIME, LLC, a creative management and production company where he manages movie and television directors and writers, as well as producing films. John is writer and executive producer for the award-winning *The Infamous Future*, a documentary highlighting the Eagle Academy for Young Men. John recently produced the 2018 March on Washington Film Festival. He has served as a sustaining board member of Youth Inc., Host Committee member for The Robin Hood Foundation, Chair of Alvin Ailey American Dance Theatre Ambassadors Committee, and is a three-time recipient of President Barack Obama's Volunteer Service Award.

"I am delighted and intrigued by the culture and empowerment of Shaker history, and am looking forward to serving on the Shaker Museum Board and contributing to diversity and community efforts," Campbell said.

Kathy Weiser recently retired after 35 years in legal administration and paralegal work. She served on the Board of Directors for 255 West 98th Street Coop in New York City for nearly 20 years and has been a part-time resident of Columbia County for the past six years. She has three adult children and four grandchildren. Her spouse Allan Weiser is the founder of Dates Weiser Furniture Corporation, makers of finely crafted furniture, which was recently acquired by Knoll.

Weiser said, "I am pleased to join the Board and contribute my energy at such an exciting inflection point."
